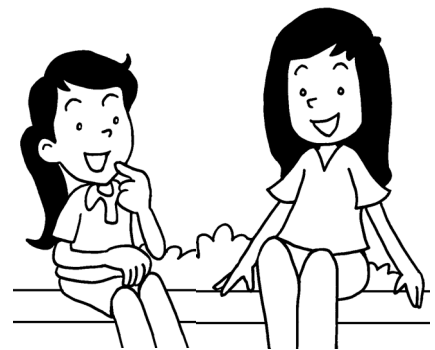

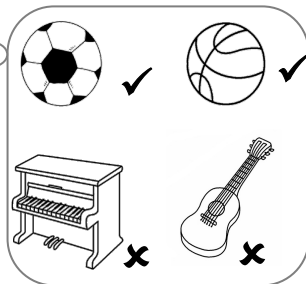

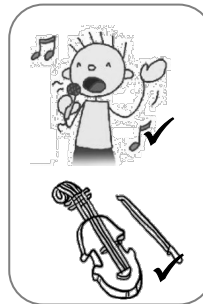

'OK,' says Charlie.

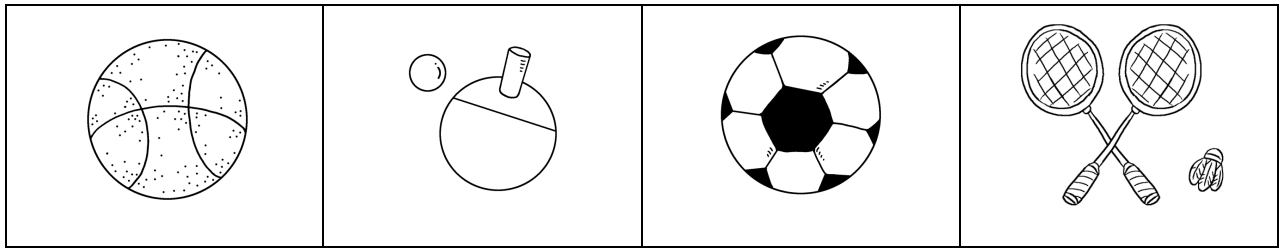
10 Knock! Knock! 'Can I come in?' asks Mum. 'Yes, Mum,' says Charlie.

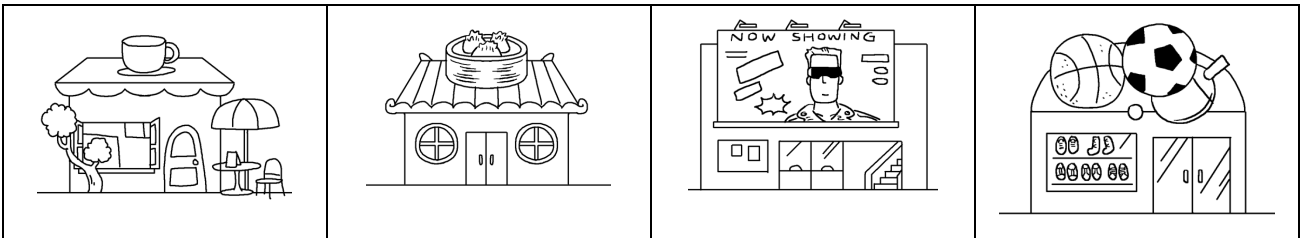
